This event will not be cancelled or rescheduled for any reason. Teams should make every attempt to participate in the event.

Facility: Watertown High School, 825 Endeavour Drive, Watertown

Directions:

If you are heading into Watertown headed...

1.) north on Hwy 26 from the Interstate I94,

you see a Taco Bell on your right at the first set of stoplights coming into town. Continue North on Hwy 26 through 5 additional sets of lights. At the 5th set of lights you will see a **Speedway** on your left across the intersection, a Walgreen's on your right, and St. Bernard's Catholic Church on the left. Go straight through the stoplight and head about a mile further north (still on Hwy 26) until you see a Cenex station on your right and some condos off to the left. Turn left at the condos onto Endeavour drive and you will see the High School. There are signs directing you to the school at Hwy 26. If you hit Hwy 16, you've gone too far.

2.) south on Hwy 26 from Hwy 60 OR East on Hwy 16 from Hwy 60,

you will pass over an intersection where Hwy 16 and Hwy 26 diverge. Continue South on Hwy 26 about 1/3 mile. The high school is on the right hand side. You should see it, but landmarks would include some condos on the right hand side, and a Cenex station on the left hand side of Hwy 26. Turn right onto Endeavour Dr and you will find the school. There are signs directing you to the school at Hwy 26.

3.) west on Hwy 16 from Oconomowoc,

you will have a choice to go into Watertown to the left, or stay on 16 to the right. Stay on Hwy 16 and in about 4 miles you will run into an "intersection" where Hwy 16 merges into Hwy 26 North. You want to go South on Hwy 26. To do this go straight under the overpass and you will turn sharply into an onramp for Hwy 26 South. Continue South on Hwy 26 about 1/3 mile. The high school is on the right hand side. You should see it, but landmarks would include some condos on the right hand side, and a Cenex station on the left hand side of Hwy 26. Turn right onto Endeavour Dr and you will find the school. There are signs directing you to the school at Hwy 26.

4.) east on Hwy 19 from Waterloo/Marshall/Sun Prairie/Madison,

you will enter town and go under a railroad track. Immediately after the railroad overpass you will see a Kwik Trip on your left hand side. Turn left immediately after the Kwik Trip onto Carriage Hill Drive and you will see the High School on your right hand side. You will need to follow Carriage Hill to Endeavour and turn right on Endeavour to get to the entrance.

Important Facts:

- Teams that have not turned in their SIGNUPTOPLAY roster and USAV numbers for their team will not be eligible to participate. (NO EXCEPTIONS).
- Coaches must sign off on acceptable SIGNUPTOPLAY roster before competing in any matches on the day of the event.
- There will not be a coaches meeting, any changes will be provided to you when checking and signing the acceptable SIGNUPTOPLAY roster.
- No food may be brought into the facility. Any coolers must be kept in the car.
- Concessions will be provided by the River City Volleyball Club.
- No gum, food, or beverages (other than water) will be allowed in the gym.
- Gym bags should be put left in the commons area of the school (commons area will be marked at the entrance to the facility).
- Watertown School District nor River City Volleyball Club will be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Region up referees will arrive by 2:00 pm for the Medal rounds, based on availability within the Region. Warm-up time starts immediately following the conclusion of the previous match. We need to stay on schedule.
- Teams must provide an up official (R1) down official (R2), scorekeeper, libero scorekeeper, and 2 line judges.
- Admission is \$2 we will have a full menu for the entire tournament, please patronize our concessions.
- Please be sure to bring your med. kits. Ice and Band-Aids will be provided.

Rules: USA Volleyball rules will be utilized. There will be a tournament directors table set up in the gym area. Teams that have officiating duties must bring the completed score sheets to that table before the start of warm-ups for the next match.

Warm-ups: Team warm-ups will consist of 4-4-4 prior to their first match of play (four shared ball handling, then four of each team having their court time to attack and serve). There will not be any shared serving time. All other warm ups will be 2-2-1 (2 on, 2 off, 1 serving). The first match of the day will start on time. All matches that follow may run ahead of schedule in pools of 4. It is the responsibility of each team to follow the progress on their next assignment court and be ready to play when the court is available.

Format: Matches will consist of best of three. The first two games rally score to 25 points and the third if necessary rally scored to 15 points. All games are win by two, no cap. The event is scheduled to conclude by or near 5:00 pm. The site director will determine whether playoff rounds will be condensed based on the time playoffs will start and considering how many rounds of playoff will be required.

- **Tie Breakers:** Badger Region guidelines will be followed. Playoff games in tie-break situations going to Gold will consist of one game to 15 points, no warm-up time. This process should allow all the teams to have a minimum of four matches, and end the day at a reasonable hour. Any questions please ask the site directors.
