Thank you for participating in the Whitewater Open tournament Series at UW-Whitewater. In order for a smooth and successful tournament, please read the following information and share it with all coaches, players and spectators.

FORMAT: Pool play followed by single elimination playoffs.

- Four-team pools will play a best of three match play format
- Rally scoring to 25 points for the first two games and to 15 for the third if necessary (no cap)
- Playoffs will be best of three match play format

SCHEDULE: UW-Whitewater Williams Center – Volleyball Arena (please refer to UW-W map)

7:10a.m Doors open
7:30a.m Coaches meeting in Room 184
7:50a.m First round warm-up begins (3,3,3,1)
8:00a.m First serve

- Warm-ups will be 3,3,3,1 before the first two matches. After that warm-ups will be 2,2,1.
- Top two teams in each pool advance to the Gold Championships and the bottom teams will go in the Silver or Bronze Divisions. Medals for winner of Gold Championship.
- All coaches must sign off on their SIGNUPTOPLAY roster on day of tournament. **Please make sure your coach has an extra copy of their STP roster.** Teams that have not turned in their SIGNUPTOPLAY roster and USAV numbers for their team will not be eligible to participate. **(NO EXCEPTIONS!)**
- We will provide the up referee for each match. Teams assigned to officiate must provide a down official, scorekeeper, libero tracker, & line judges. Be sure to be on court and ready for all officiating duties. Do not leave without checking with the tournament director that you are finished officiating.
- **No carry-ins into the building other than water bottles for athletes. NO COOLERS IN THE BUILDING. WATER ONLY in the gym!! Thank you for your cooperation!!!**
- Concessions will be sold. Please clean up your garbage after all matches and upon leaving the facility.
- Please demonstrate respect the facilities, referees, other spectators and Tournament Officials!!
- Neither the UW-Whitewater nor the Tournament Directors are responsible for lost or stolen items.
- **A \$2 admission fee will be charged for all spectators.**
- Tournament Directors will be monitoring courts on a continuous basis throughout the tournament.
- ***Violations of any facility rules will result in your team forfeiting games and/or your club being fined.***
- A Certified trainer and ice will not be available.
- UW-Whitewater Volleyball apparel will be available in the lobby.

Directions to Williams Center at UW-Whitewater

Williams Center
Warhawk Drive

From the East:

- Follow Hwy. 12 (west – there is a bypass around Whitewater)
- Turn right on S. Janesville Street (second set of stoplights on bypass)
- Turn left on Main Street
- Turn right on Prairie Street stoplights
- Turn left on Starin Rd.
- Turn right on Warhawk Drive (you will see Williams Center directly in front of you)
- Park in Williams Center lot on right before you get to Williams Center

From the West:

- Follow Hwy. 12 (east – there is a bypass around Whitewater) and turn left on Walworth Avenue
- Turn left on Elizabeth Street (Whitewater HS will be on the right)
- Turn right on Main Street
- Turn left on Tratt Street (at stoplight by the McDonald's)
- Turn right on Schwager Drive. Over the hill, you will see Williams Center directly in front of you
- Follow Schwager Drive and turn right at 4-way stop when you see Williams Center on right and Perkins Stadium on left
- Drive past Williams Center and park in Williams Center lot on left

From the North:

- Follow Hwy. N (south) into town
- Turn left on Schwager Drive. Over the hill, you will see Williams Center directly in front of you
- Follow Schwager Drive and turn right at 4-way stop when you see Williams Center on right and Perkins Stadium on left
- Drive past Williams Center and park in Williams Center lot on left

OR

- Follow Hwy. 59 (west) to Hwy. 12
- Turn right on Hwy. 12 (west) and follow "From the East" directions

From the South:

- Follow Hwy. 89/59 (east/north) into town
- Turn left on Main Street (also known as Hwy. 12-west)
- Turn right on Prairie Street stoplights
- Turn left on Starin Rd.
- Turn right on Warhawk Drive (you will see Williams Center directly in front of you)
- Park in Williams Center lot on right before you get to Williams Center
